





Dr. Tim Dishongh is a co-founder of CAC and a worship pastor in San Antonio TX. Tim's expertise includes worship, performance practice, and vocal pedagogy. Tim holds a Master of Music in Vocal Performance and Vocal Pedagogy, a Master of Arts, and a Doctorate in Worship Studies. Tim has been teaching and training singers and worship leaders for over 20 years and his goal is to build into every singer a singing technique that promotes versatility, vocal health, and overall freedom. Tim helps singers to produce a voice that is seamless and that can move effectively between classical, pop, worship, and other musical styles. Many of Tim's former students are now professional musicians and accomplished worship leaders. Tim has taught voice on the collegiate level, instructored singers for a major talent scouting organization, and maintained a thriving private studio for over 20 years. Tim has also won many awards for singing and acting including 1st place male vocalist and overall vocal winner for the National Association of Teachers of Singing. He also was a Texas Globe Award finalist for a leading role in a musical. Tim has released several successful albums including a worship album which generated a top ten hit.

Trained as a classical pianist, Lyn applies her skills and talents to instruct students from beginner to advanced, teaching to the individual student, not a set curriculum. Proper technique is the foundation of every great musician, and even though lessons are tailored to each student, technique is never compromised. Lyn enjoys all genres and works within the student's genre preferences to keep them engaged, ready to learn, and develop as a musician. # WHAT IS EXPECTED





#### **ATTENDANCE**



Regular attendance is considered mandatory! If a student needs to cancel, they can either manage their schedule on the portal or speak to their instructor.

Lessons cancelled within 24 hrs will not be guaranteed a make up. A student may not have more than six cancellations, without extenuating circumstances. Make up credits expire after 180 days. No-shows are not given a make-up, and not refunded.

#### **PARENTS**



Parents are welcome to attend lessons, and are respectfully asked to refrain from all interruptions. This includes well meant actions such as helping the instructor or verbally instructing their student. We ask that parents use headphones if watching content and refrain from all calls in the classroom, even with headphones. Please do not bring snacks and any drink must be in a to-go cup with a lid.

#### ETIQUETTE



Our lesson space is a family friendly environment! We ask that all students and observers keep professional and encouraging language, aligned with our values of being B.R.A.V.E. We adhere to typical school policy for clothing, and ask that those coming from athletics take time to freshen up. Come to class prepared with necessary materials, practiced, and ready for instruction.

#### **PRACTICE**



Practice at home is also considered mandatory, as it's the best predictor of success! Lessons are not practice times. Instructors will recommend the best practice schedule and help students learn how to practice. Instructors have discretion regarding lesson changes and concert participation for students who chronically come to lessons having not practiced.

#### **CONCERTS**




Concerts are our end of term recitals.

Participation is mandatory, save for extenuating circumstances. These are professionally produced events, using state-of-the-art audio and visual support. Concert fees are assessed each term in order to cover expenses for production teams and student celebrations. The event is livestreamed and posted for replay on our social media.

#### **BILLING**



Administration fees are paid directly to CAC, while lessons fees are paid directly to your instructor. Instructors keep 100% of lesson fees. They will determine payment options. CAC accepts cash, check, or online payments. All invoices are due within 30 days, and a \$20 late fee is automatically assessed to all unpaid invoices. Students can see and manage their account on the student portal. All invoices are paperless!





# **POLICIES & PROCEDURES**

#### **CONTACTING US**

Who to Contact: When you have questions, follow this rule of thumb for the quickest solution.

- Contact your instructor with questions about your student portal, curriculum, or progress.
- <u>Contact the office</u> for questions about billing, enrollment, safety concerns, and merch.

#### MANAGING YOUR ACCOUNT

**Enrollment**: All students are enrolled by the leadership staff using My Music Staff. Students (and parents) have a unique login to manage their account, access resources, and see coursework provided by their instructor. Students with multiple classes will have access with the same login.

- fees: As a non-profit, your instructor receives 100% of the tuition paid! There is a one time \$25 registration fee for all students per enrollment and a \$50 recital fee due at that time.
- **choosing an instructor**: All students may request an instructor, however the leadership will make the final assignment to an instructor based on availability, skill level, and goals.
- **expectations**: All students should refer to this handbook for policies and expectations regarding the commitment a student makes in enrolling for music instruction.
- removal: Concerns about a student's failure to uphold these commitments will be addressed in a 3 step process: 1) instructor will speak with the student at least twice, then either with parents (where applicable) or a third time with referral to the leadership staff; 2) leadership will assess the situation and provide a path for continued membership; 3) following the next recital, unresolved concerns may result in the student being unenrolled.

**Withdrawal**: Withdrawal from classes requires <u>four weeks</u> notice, during which the student may attend the remaining classes with their regular payment plan, or pay the amount in full and stop attendance immediately.

#### SAFTEY STANDARDS

Creative Arts Conservatory is committed to the health and safety of our community. As such, we adhere to the following protocols to ensure student wellbeing:

- Background checks and in-house vetting of each instructor.
- Cameras and oversight of all teaching spaces.
- Cleanliness of shared instruments and spaces.
- Training for staff, to include guidelines on appropriate teaching methods.
- Open communication regarding all health and safety concerns.
- Instructors will meet new students at the main doors at their first visit, and then will only release youth students to their parents at the classroom.
- CAC reserves the right to remove any person on campus who is deemed a danger to the health and safety of our community.





# TUITION, BILL PAY, & SCHOLARSHIPS

### **Tuition & Bill Pay**

Administration fees are paid directly to CAC via CASH, CHECK, or ONLINE.

- There is an annual registration fee of \$25 per student\*.
- Each term includes a mandatory concert with a \$30 fee per student.
- Accounts/Invoices for registration and concert fees can be seen on the portal.
- Late fee of \$20 are automatically applied to all invoices after 28 days.
- Online payments are accepted through the link provided on the invoice.
  - please consider including a donation to cover fees for online payments!

Lesson fees are paid directly to the instructor via CASH, CHECK, or APP.

- Each instructor sets their own pricing, \*\*approved by CAC leadership.
  - Any family discounts or other coupons are at the discretion of the instructor.
  - Prices range from \$20 \$40, based on the instructor's disctretion.
- Instructors will have bill pay preferences for per lesson, monthly, or term:
  - All intervals are acceptable, however late fees apply for unpaid invoices after 28 days.
- Instructors may choose to offer online payments via apps of their preference.
- All revenue is recorded with CAC for tax purposes.
- Invoices will be available in the portal, but paid to your instructor.
  - Confirm payment policy with your instructor they may add online payment to invoice!
- If an instructor resigns before the end of a lesson year (Aug June), a new instructor will be offered at the same price for the remainder of that year.
- If a student shows exceptional talent, they may be offered advanced instruction.
  - If accepted, lesson fees set by advanced instructor will apply.

### **Scholarships**

Our goal is to provide holistic music coaching that is tailored to the student. In order to serve <u>all</u> students, we seek donations so we can offer financial aid to students. Scholarships are distributed annually, and may cover up to 100% of lesson fees\*\*\*\*.

The deadline for applications is **4 weeks before the start of fall lessons**. Paper copies are available by request.

The distribution of funds is determined by the CAC leadership team.\*\*\* This is not an audition based decision. All decisions are made in good faith to serve our community of students with excellence so that all may have the opportunity to receive the benefits of learning creative arts.

<sup>\*</sup>The registration fee is automatically applied annually.

<sup>\*\*</sup>CAC leadership requires instructor pricing to not exceed reasonable alignment with the individual instructor's experience and education.

\*\*\*The CAC leadership may include independent advisors, including those from Leon Spring Baptist Church. All personally identifying information will be kept secure and private, consider controlled unclassified information (CUI). This CUI will not be shared outside of the decision team.

Please speak to CAC staff regarding any concerns about this team and CUI.

<sup>\*\*\*\*</sup>Scholarships may offer coverage of concert (recital) fees. However, all students, regardless of scholarship, are required to pay the registration fee of \$25 per student annually.


## TIPS FOR SUCCESS!

- Create a habit of practicing! Start with 10 minutes 2 days a week, then 3 days, then 4 and 5.... then increase by 5 minutes each day till you reach 30 minutes or more.
